JOB DESCRIPTION PART TIME MINISTER OF YOUTH

Qualifications:

- 1. Give evidence of a divine call into Christian Ministry
- 2. Maintain a daily walk with the Lord Jesus Christ
- 3. Adequately meet the needs of spouse and children
- 4. Maintain all financial obligations and be recognized as a respected ethical person of the community
- 5. Possess an attitude of service and ministry to others
- 6. Be supportive of total church ministries through prayer, tithes and attendance

Specific Responsibilities:

- 1. Develop a comprehensive youth program
- 2. Lead regular training for youth workers
- 3. Counsel with youth, youth workers and parents in the planning and conducting of special projects, such as retreats and youth camps
- 4. Work with church nominating committee in the enlistment of qualified youth workers
- 5. Meet quarterly with Sunday school teachers to plan activities and keep members informed of upcoming activities and plans
- 6. Counsel with youth workers and parents regarding curriculum, space, equipment and educational methods/needs
- 7. Develop and maintain youth choir/band (optional)
- 8. Work with students grade levels of seven through twelve
- 9. Meet regularly with the Executive Pastor and work under his general supervision
- 10. Coordinate with Executive Pastor in maintaining regular office hours
- 11. Maintain at least fourteen hours per week in Youth Ministry
- 12. Coordinate and participate in Sunday school outreach and regular church visitation
- 13. Monitor Youth Ministry expenditures to maintain the Youth Ministry budget
- 14. He/She shall have a minimum of one youth activity per month
- 15. He/She shall encourage modesty in dress for all youth activities including church worship attendance
- 16. He/She shall assist in administrative responsibilities as assigned by the Executive Pastor
- 17. He/She shall be considered a minister of the church and may assist in the worship services as directed by the Executive Pastor
- 18. He/She shall be allowed to continue his/her education at Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary while serving LPBC
- 19. He/She will be allowed one week paid leave for youth work/youth pastor service and the church will pay a substitute at a discounted rate (church camp pastor/leader for another church or church group, etc)
- 20. He/She is required to coordinate and attend Youth Camp
